Since January 2004, Colonel Bryant has served Governor Perdue as the Deputy Executive Director of the Georgia Military Affairs Coordinating Committee.

He retired in 1999, after thirty years active military service, as the Senior Legal Advisor for Third U.S. Army/ Army Forces Central Command, Fort McPherson, Georgia. From 1969 until 1978, Bryant served in various command and staff positions in airborne and light infantry units. From 1978 until 1999, he served in the Judge Advocate General's (JAG) Corps as the Senior Legal Advisor, U.S. Army Special Operations Command, the Senior Legal Advisor, XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg, the Director, National Security Legal Studies, U.S. Army War College, and the Senior Legal Advisor, U.S. Southern Command.

Colonel Bryant has a B.A. in English from Ohio University, a J. D. from the University of Puget Sound School of Law, and is a graduate of the U.S. Army War College, Carlisle, Pennsylvania.
