Since February 2002, I have been the Transit Division Manager of Cobb Community Transit. Cobb Community Transit is the county's municipal bus system that provides both fixed route and complementary paratransit service. Complementary paratransit service is provided to disabled individuals, who, due to the nature of their disability cannot access the fixed route system.

Prior to relocating to Cobb County, I spent 11 years as the Executive Director of the Hammond Transit System in Hammond, Indiana. Hammond, Indiana is located in northwest Indiana, is positioned on the shores of Lake Michigan, and is approximately 20 miles from downtown Chicago. The service provided by the Hammond Transit System is very similar to the service provided by CCT.

I began my career in transportation as a Transportation Planner for the Northwestern Indiana Regional Planning Commission.
