David Cummings is an Atlanta-based tech entrepreneur who has founded 10 companies employing thousands of people, including Pardot, Salesloft, and Intown Golf Club. David is also the founder of the Atlanta Tech Village — the United States' 4th largest tech hub — and the lead investor in Calendly, the world's most popular scheduling app. After selling Pardot, he was named the Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year winner and one of the 100 Most Influential Atlantans by the Atlanta Business Chronicle.
